1	Click on GIS Mapping Tool, "Map Lookup"
2	Click on Tools icon in top right corner (screw driver and wrench).
3	Check Tool Lables box.
4	Click 2019 Aerial imagery if not already selected (bottom left of map).
5	Click Search tab or Search link.
6	Enter APN.
7	Click Search button.
8	Click Measure/Draw tab.
9	Select Area.
10	Change Distance Units to Feet (ft) (far left dropdown, top row)
11	Change Area Units to Acres (ac) (far left dropdown, bottom row)
12	Click on map to begin measuring and shading your parcel(s). A single click will create a point. Double click to
	complete your measurement. The area measurement will be displayed on your map. Note: The Irrigation
	Allowance Index Application requires that you measure irrigated acres only. Do not include roads in the irrigated
	acreage. You may need to zoom out to complete this task.
13	To add text, choose Text from the Draw tools (default setting 'Point', drop-down arrow to select "T" and enable
	Styles).
	Select Styles to choose a text style or create your own text style.
	Type desired text to lable crop type, well location, APN, or other applicable information.
	Click a location on map to add text.
17	To edit drawings or text choose Edit, Erase, or Clear . Choose EDIT to move points on a drawing, rotate or enlarge
	text. Choose Erase to permanently erase a drawing or text. Choose Clear to permanently clear all drawings and
	text.
	Click Home tab to enabel the the Print function.
	Click the Print icon on the Tasks ribbon.
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	Choose paper size and orientation from Select Layout drop-down (common setting: 8.5 x 11 Landscape or Portrait)
	Output Format is PDF.
	Map Scale is Current Scale.
	Title should be CombCode and Crop Year (2020-1).
-	Notes should identify SWN, Crop Type Acreage total, or any other applicbale information.
	Arrange parcels to print in frame within shaded light red area.
-	Check Lock print preview with map to lock in place.
	Click on Print button. Wait
-	Click on Open File button to preview your map.
29	Save PDF to your computer. (i.e. 2020-1_IAI_Map_(Combcode))
