WHEREAS, the groundwater extraction charge now in effect does not provide the funding necessary to pay the USGS to work on the Fox Canyon Management Agency Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, Deering's Water Uncodified Acts, Act 2670, Section 10 as amended, grants the Board of Directors of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency the authority to levy groundwater extraction charges up to three dollars (\$3.00) per acre-foot pumped per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that effective January 1, 1996, the groundwater extraction charge shall be three dollars (\$3.00) per acre-fool pumped from facilities within the boundaries of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency.
