**DECREASING THE GROUNDWATER EXTRACTION CHARGE
FOR A SET TIME PERIOD**

WHEREAS, the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency desires to change the groundwater extraction charge for those extraction facilities located within the boundary of the Fox Canyon Management Agency, and;

WHEREAS, the groundwater extraction charge now in effect has provided extra funding for the contract with the USGS, and;

WHEREAS, Deering's Water Uncodified Acts, Act 2750, Section 1007 as amended, grants the Board of Directors of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency the authority to levy groundwater extraction charges up to three dollars (\$3.00) per acre-foot pumped per year.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that effective July 1, 1996, the groundwater extraction charge shall be two dollars and twenty cents (\$2.20) per acre-foot pumped from facilities within the boundaries of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency.

On motion by Director Carpenter, seconded by Director Flynn, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted on this 25th DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1996.


