A RESOLUTION

TO PROTECT GROUNDWATER IN THE OXNARD PLAIN FOREBAY BASIN

WHEREAS, the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency is responsible for the management of the quantity and quality of groundwater within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Oxnard Plain Forebay Basin (Forebay) is within the boundary of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, development on the Forebay can significantly impact groundwater quality of the Forebay and the Oxnard Plain Pressure Basins; and

WHEREAS, the sensitivity of the Forebay has been intensified by deep gravel pits along the Santa Clara River that have been mined to a depth that exposes groundwater.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that:

- A. Runoff from on-site or offsite, resulting from a storm event of up to 10 years, must not be allowed to enter the deep pits unless the runoff has been treated to the most stringent of the following standards: 1) the primary EPA Drinking Water Standards, or 2) primary State Drinking Water Standards, or 3) the average groundwater existing in the Forebay as measured at a well downgradient to the UWCD Saticoy Spreading Grounds; and
- B. Any solution involving the percolation of untreated water, shall provide for that water to pass through a minimum of a 10 foot of vadose zone before reaching the level of historic high groundwater or horizontally in the aquifer if it can be demonstrated that some horizontal filtration distance is equivalent to a 10 foot vadose zone; and
- C. Treatment and filtration must be designed to accommodate flows of up to 10-year storm events; and
- D. Any treatment option for runoff water must be evaluated thoroughly and established to be effective before it can be considered; and
- E. Any bodies of water, deep pits or excavations in the Forebay shall receive long term management by an agency approved by the Fox Canyon GMA.
