WHEREAS, under pumping a historical allocation will result in creation of credits; and

WHEREAS, delivery of this water replaces groundwater that would otherwise be pumped; and


WHEREAS, this recycled water would otherwise be lost to the Ocean; and

WHEREAS, the direct delivery of water will help the depleted aquifer recover lost water levels; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has the ability to grant credits for this injected water;


