We authorize the Staff to issue a billing on the assessment for 50% of the assessment effective March 1 with the balance to be billed in a supplemental billing on June 1, and between those time, Staff will report back to the Finance Committee and to the Board concerning adjustments and actual expenditures so that we can see whether or not a revised assessment would actually lower the assessment and either extinguish or reduce the June first billing.

- **C. Agenda Review:** There were no requested changes to the agenda.
- **D. Public Comments:** There were no public comments.
- **E. PAC Member Comments:**

Laurel Servin, representing mutual water companies in the East Las Posas, reiterated her concern that the \$64 per acre foot fee includes items that are excessive and duplicative. Ms. Servin is of the opinion that the only sizable and non-duplicative new expenses for the first year are the cost of the TAC members, the PAC Administrator, and some administrative work by the Watermaster. Ms. Servin would like the entire PAC to have ample opportunity to review and vote on the Watermaster budget and other financial issues using the same method as the nominating committee used, meaning the budget sub-committee reviews and shares results with the full PAC prior to the commencement of billing.

Regarding stakeholder communications, Ms. Servin is concerned that many farmers in the basin, both large and small ag operators, have no knowledge of what the PAC/TAC are doing for them, nor are they expecting additional assessments. Ms. Servin proposes getting some communication out to WMID holders so they understand what is happening as a result of the adjudication and to prepare them for the new assessments coming soon.

F. Regular Agenda

1. Approve the minutes of the February 1, 2024, Meeting: Richard Cavaletto made a motion to approve the minutes as stated for the February 1, 2024, meeting; John Menne seconded the motion which passed with unanimous consent.

2. Committee Consultation

 Water Year (WY) 2023 Annual Allocation: The PAC reviewed the Watermasterprovided revised (WY) 2023 Annual Allocation schedule. It was approved unanimously.

3. TAC Nominations – Closed Session – Public Employee Appointment

- At 3:20 P.M., pursuant to California Government Code 54957, the PAC convened in a closed session to confer regarding the nomination of Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) members.
- b. The closed session was terminated at 4:25 P.M., and regular session resumed. The PAC nominating subcommittee performed seventeen initial candidate interviews, and narrowed the list to six finalists, who were each interviewed by the PAC panel during the week of February 5, 2024. After discussion and votes for each position, the following TAC nominations were reported after the closed session:
 - i. Selection for TAC Administrator nominee is Chad Taylor vote was approved unanimously
 - ii. Selection for East LPV TAC member nominee is Tony Morgan vote was approved unanimously
 - iii. Selection for West LPV TAC member nominee is Bob Abrams vote was approved unanimously

The PAC Chair will create a letter for delivery to the Watermaster which will name the nominees for consideration and approval by the Watermaster at the next FCGMA Board of Directors' meeting on February 28, 2024.
