Subject: Item D - OPV Stakeholder Engagement

The Agency implemented a stakeholder facilitation process in the Oxnard and Pleasant Valley (OPV) Basins in 2020 through a California Department of Water Resources (DWR) grant program. The Consensus Building Institute (CBI) was the firm provided by DWR. DWR ended its funding for CBI in November 2020 and the Agency stepped in to provide funding for CBI through the end of the year. At the December 14, 2020 meeting, the Board directed that stakeholder engagement continue with engagement of the Board committees. The purpose of this joint meeting of the OPV Stakeholder Group and the Executive Committee is to kick-off the effort and lay out the work plan for the next four months leading to a report to the Board at the April 28, 2021 meeting. Agency staff is working to engage a consultant to assist with the facilitation process. The work plan will be brought to the full Board at the January 27, 2021 meeting.

The goal of this phase of the facilitated stakeholder engagement process is to complete work tasks to develop consensus on issues to advance implementation of the Agency's groundwater sustainability plans leading to sustainable management of the basins as required by the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). Key work plan tasks are:

- OPV Starting Allocation
- Sustainable Yield
- Ramp-down / Minimum Allocation

The Projects Committee will continue its efforts, with timing largely dependent on United Water Conservation District's (UWCD) modeling of the hybrid suite of projects recommended by the committee for modeling with which the Stakeholder Group concurred. Additionally, FCGMA is working to implement a replenishment fee, initially focused on supplemental water for recharge and other near-term projects. Findings and recommendations of FCGMA's rate consultant will be brought to a Fiscal Committee meeting, tentatively scheduled for March.


