1.3 1.2 1.1 1	11 Dec 1996 26 May 1993 29 May 1992 27 May 1983	Well Registration, Reporting and Extraction Charge Ordinance – The ordinance requires that all well owners with extraction facilities within the boundaries of the Agency register their wells with the FCGMA, report annual extraction and pay an annual groundwater extraction charge. This ordinance has been superseded to include the requirements of Ordinance 2 and Ordinance 6.
2	28 Oct 1983	Amendment to Ordinance 1 replacing the annual requirements for reporting and payment of charges to semi-annually. Superseded by Ordinance 1.1.
3.2 3.1 3	24 Jan 2001 28 July 1993 27 Feb 1987	Metering Ordinance – This ordinance requires all wells other than domestic or inactive be equipped with a flowmeter. If an inactive well is reactivated or used for 12 hours or more in any calendar year, it is considered active, and thus requires a meter. Any well extractions of less than 12 hours per year still had to be reported to the FCGMA, and appropriate fees would have to be paid.
4.3 4.2 4.1 4	28 Mar 2001 25 Oct 1995 28 June 1995 24 July 1987	Las Posas Basin Groundwater Extraction Prohibition Ordinance - This ordinance prohibits any increase in groundwater use or construction of new wells on or above the Lower Aquifer System (LAS) outcrop or other non-water bearing areas within the East, West, or South Las Posas basins along the perimeter of the basins. All proposed well permit uses in these basins are subject to Agency approval.

It also provides for historical, baseline and efficiency allocations, credits for under pumping and penalties for pumping more groundwater than provided by an allocation. Details on all of the possible annual allocations, historical allocation reduction schedule, earning and/or transfers of allocation or credits, and other aspects are all explained and codified in Ordinance 5 versions. Penalties and hearing procedures to allow both the Board of Directors and well operator/owners to have adequate opportunities for redress or discourse were also included.
6	26 June 1991	Emergency Ordinance amending Ordinance 2, increasing the amount of the groundwater extraction charge. Superseded by Ordinance 1.1.
7	24 July 1991	This Ordinance amended Ordinance 5 relating to the waste of water. Superseded by Ordinance 5.2.

Revision No. 4 was effective from the date of adoption until December 31, 2011.
<a href="#">Emergency - E</a>	11 April 2014	This Ordinance limits extractions from groundwater extraction facilities, suspends use of credits, and prohibits construction of any groundwater extraction facility and/or the issuance of any permit therefor.
<a href="#">Amendment to Ordinance E</a>	13 December 2019	An Amendment to Emergency Ordinance E repeals Article 2.C of Emergency Ordinance E, with respect to groundwater extractions subject to temporary extraction allocations beginning on January 1, 2020. This amendment restores temporary allocations for municipal and industrial operators.
Ordinance 8.8	09 Jan 2015	An ordinance to amend the Fox Canyon GMA ordinance code relating to extraction surcharges for exceeding an irrigation allowance index of 1.0 and imposing an agency wide cap on agricultural extractions

The separate "Compensation and Reimbursement Policy," attached hereto as Exhibit A, further authorizes, and establishes the policies and procedures for, the reimbursement of specified actual and necessary expenses incurred by Board members during the performance of their official duties. This Ordinance became effective 60 days after adoption date, on Tuesday, January 13, 2026.
